ALWAYS STAY HUMBLE AND KIND

What does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? Micah 6:8

According to Micah, walking humbly with God is one of the big three requirements for God's people. Yet we are a people who take pride in our achievements; our accumulated "stuff;" our power, individually and nationally. Left unchecked, we can fall into an exhausting pattern of always having to be in control and on top of things, accomplishing everything from our own resources. We may even begin to point out others' faults to make us feel better.

Humility is not the same as beating yourself up or letting other people put you down. Humility is not the same as low self-esteem, and it's not the opposite of confidence. Humility is not underestimating our worth or allowing ourselves to be defined by another. In fact, humility is "the grateful recognition that we are precious in God's eyes and that all we are is pure gift." (*Bread for the Journey*, by Henri J.M. Nouwen, ©1997). The truly humble person walks with absolute confidence, knowing that we are simply empty vessels through whom God wants to accomplish his work.

"[Humility] is not something that we bring to God, or that [God] bestows; it is simply the sense of entire nothingness that comes when we see how truly God is everything. When the creature realizes that this is a place of honor and consents to be with his will, his mind, and his affections — the vessel in which the life and glory of God are to work and manifest themselves, [the creature] sees that humility is simply acknowledging the truth of his position as creature and yielding to God his place." (From *Humility: The Journey Toward Holiness*, by Andrew Murray, © 2001)

Perhaps Tim McGraw sums it up best in these verses from his hit song, "Humble and Kind:"

Go to church cause your mama says to Visit grandpa every chance that you can It won't be a waste of time Always stay humble and kind

When the dreams you're dreamin' come to you
When the work you put in is realized
Let yourself feel the pride but
Always stay humble and kind

Don't expect a free ride from no one Don't hold a grudge or a chip and here's why Bitterness keeps you from flying Always stay humble and kind

Hold the door say please say thank you Don't steal don't cheat and don't lie I know you got mountains to climb but Always stay humble and kind


The Committee That Keeps You Busy on Weekends – also known as the Christian Fellowship Committee – is going to give you a summer break, with only one major event scheduled in each month.


